

Steps to Applying - General Information



Program Costs \$1300

- **Full Program Costs for February to June 2025** The charge to a student will be related to the direct costs incurred that are in addition to the costs of providing a standard educational program. Such as; PGA Teaching Professionals, facility use, golf rounds during class time, program clothing, some player equipment/gear, athlete transportation, outside facility costs, and honorariums for guest coaches & instructors, etc.
- An initial deposit cheque of \$250.00 made out to School District #63 must be submitted/attached to each application: once a student receives written confirmation (by way of email, on or after March 17th) that they have been accepted into the CSI program, this initial deposit cheque will be cashed and the amount will be deducted from the total cost for their particular sport that is listed above.
- This initial deposit of \$250 is nonrefundable and will only be cashed if the student is accepted.
- Any families who do not use cheques, please contact the Claremont accounts department <u>before March</u> 17th (250-658-6672) in order to pass along your credit card information so that a payment can be made upon confirmation of acceptance into the program; a student will not gain acceptance into the CSI program without some form of initial deposit payment information on file.
- The balance of the CSI Golf program payment is due by September 30, 2024 in full or with post-dated cheques until full payment is received. Please contact the Claremont Principal, Mr. Buckham, if you would like more information regarding fees and/or hardship, CSI is a program of choice and fees are required. All conversations are strictly confidential.
