

- Easy access to the many city sporting facilities such as the heated swimming pools, cycling velodrome, enormous range of sports clubs
- Specialist sport training for elite sporting students
- Many diverse sporting activities including: rowing and kayaking on our river, athletics, softball, touch rugby, rugby, cricket, hockey, football, basketball, badminton, tennis, volleyball, skiing in winter, surf lifesaving, as well as less traditional sports such as triathlons, mountain biking, swimming and equestrian sports.

#### **OUTDOOR EDUCATION**

Whanganui High School has its own school hut (overnight accommodation) in Tongariro National Park and has a full Outdoor Education Programme with an emphasis on:

- Environmental awareness
- Safety and enjoyment of the outdoors
- Kayaking, Camping, Navigation, High Ropes, Tramping, Rock Climbing, Bushcraft, Water Safety, Mountain Biking and Adventure based learning.

We also have a six month Outdoor Education Programme for non-examination students called Conservation New Zealand. On this course, students experience the following:

- · Go on an outdoors trip nearly every week
- Learn about Maori culture
- · Learn about New Zealand flora and fauna
- Prepare and plan for enjoying outdoor pursuits
- · Experience activities such as Kayaking, High Ropes, Hiking, Tramping, Rock Climbing
- · Assist with and learn about local conservation initiatives.
