- The cell phone was invented by Winnipegger Martin Cooper
- In 1914 a WW1 captain from Winnipeg took an orphaned black bear names after his hometown to England as a regiment mascot. He left the bear at the London Zoo where he was visited by A.A. Milne and his son Christopher Robin, and became the inspiration for Winnie the Pooh
- James Bond was inspired by Winnipegger Sir William Stephenson, whose story was first immortalized in Ian Fleming 's A Man Called Intrepid
- Winnipeg was the first city in North America to use the 911 central emergency number
- The Harlequin Romance publishing empire was founded in Winnipeg in 1949
