Avondale College's Outdoor Education programme is designed to challenge and inspire students as they pursue their passion for the environment and the outdoors.

Join a small class of highly motivated senior students as they journey around the North Island, experiencing adventures such as tramping, rock climbing, kayaking, caving and mountain biking. Included is also an expedition to Avondale College's Taurewa outdoor education centre based near the World Heritage Tongariro National park.

Students in the Outdoor Education programme will also participate in several outdoor pursuits during school time and work towards gaining internationally recognized credits in the National Certificate of Achievement (NCEA).

In addition, students have the opportunity to pursue optional trips offered throughout the year, enabling them to experience snorkelling, caving, rock climbing and more. Leadership skills gained as part of the programme can be further endorsed through participation in the Duke of Edinburgh Award.
