Our Courses

We work with students and families to determine courses that best fit their individual strengths and needs.

Hutt Valley High School teaches NCEA (National Certificate of Educational Achievement), the New Zealand national high school qualification. This qualification is recognised world-wide.

Our School Day

A normal school day starts at 9:00am and finishes at 3:15pm. Students have five classes each day and scheduled time with their form class. Students study eight subjects in Year 10, six subjects in Year 11 and 12 and five subjects in Year 13.

Extra-curricular activities including sport, clubs and music are scheduled before and after school, on weekends or during lunchtimes.

Our School Year in New Zealand

Our school year has four terms of approximately 10 weeks each. As NCEA assessments occur throughout the year students are able to begin school at any time but starting in February allows students to access all of the subjects, sports and clubs we have available.

Homestay

Our international students are hosted by local families. Most of our homestay families have had long term connections with the school. The families will either have students currently attending, or recently finished at Hutt Valley High School.

New Zealand homes are generally large and spacious with outdoor areas and pets. Homestay accommodation includes 3 meals per day and unlimited internet access.

English Language Support

Hutt Valley High School is a leader in providing high quality English Language programmes, taught by highly qualified, experienced staff. Students can enrol in as many as three English Language classes as a part of their academic pathway. All students have an English Language placement test during their enrolment and orientation.

There are English Language classes at all levels of proficiency from beginner to advanced. We also offer an English Language NCEA programme for students who want to gain entry to a New Zealand university. Help is available to support students with their English in other curriculum classes such as Science or Geography.

Application Requirements

When you are ready to complete an online enrolment for your student, please make sure you have scanned copies of the following documents ready to upload before you begin:

- · Current passport (if available)
- Photo of the student (portrait photo, passport photo or similar)
- · Students latest school report (translated into English)
- Vaccination certificate (if available and must be in English)

Once you've compiled these documents, completing the online application takes less than 15 minutes.

Medical & Travel Insurance

The Code of Practice and New Zealand Immigration Service requires all International students studying in New Zealand to have full travel and medical insurance while in New Zealand. The insurance policy must be compliant with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority and the Code of Practice requirements.
